The Emergency Powers (Amendment) Order 1973

Made ---18th April 1973Laid before Parliament27th April 1973Coming into Operation18th May 1973

At the Court at Windsor Castle, the 18th day of April 1973

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by the Foreign Jurisdiction Act 1890(a), by section 5 of the West Indies Act 1962(b), and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Citation, construction and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Amendment) Order 1973.
- (2) This Order shall be construed as one with the Emergency Powers Order in Council 1939(c) (which Order as amended(d) is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and this Order and the Emergency Powers Orders in Council 1939 to 1968(e) may be cited together as the Emergency Powers Orders in Council 1939 to 1973.
 - (3) This Order shall come into operation on 18th May 1973.

Amendment of section 2(1) of the principal Order

- 2. Sub-section (1) of section 2 of the principal Order is amended—
- (a) by deleting the words "the Central and Southern Line Islands" in paragraph (b); and
- (b) by deleting the words "the Cayman Islands," and the words "or the Turks and Caicos Islands" in paragraph (c).

Amendment of First Schedule of the principal Order

3. The First Schedule to the principal Order is amended by deleting the words "Central and Southern Line Islands."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the definition of "Governor" in the Emergency Powers Order in Council 1939, as amended, in relation to the Central and Southern Line Islands, the Cayman Islands and the Turks and Caicos Islands. The Central and Southern Line Islands, which are now part of the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Colony, are deleted as a separate item in the First Schedule (territories to which the Order applies).
