SCHEDULE 1

Regulations 3(2), 4(2)(b) and 5

EXEMPTED DRUGS

- 1. Any controlled drug specified in Schedule 1 to the Misuse of Drugs Regulations 1973(1).
- **2.** Any liquid preparation designed for administration otherwise than by injection which contains any of the following substances and products, that is to say:—
 - (a) Amphetamine; dexamphetamine; levamphetamine
 - (b) Benzphetamine
 - (c) Chlorphentermine
 - (d) Mephentermine
 - (e) Methaqualone
 - (f) Methylamphetamine
 - (g) Methylphenidate
 - (h) Phendimetrazine
 - (i) Phenmetrazine
 - (j) Pipradrol
 - (k) Any stereoisomeric form of a substance specified in any of paragraphs (b) to (j) above.
 - (l) Any salt of a substance specified in any of paragraphs (a) to (k) above.
