**The Tribunals and Inquiries (Industrial Training Levy
Exemption Referees) Order 1974**

Made - - - - - 30th August 1974
Laid before Parliament 11th September 1974
Coming into Operation 3rd October 1974

The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Advocate, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 15(1) and (3) of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971(a), as amended by the Transfer of Functions (Secretary of State and Lord Advocate) Order 1972(b), hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Tribunals and Inquiries (Industrial Training Levy Exemption Referees) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 3rd October 1974.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) In this Order “the Act of 1971” means the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971.

2. Part I of Schedule 1 to the Act of 1971 shall have effect as if there were specified therein the Referees established by the Industrial Training (Levy Exemption References) Regulations 1974(d).

3. Section 13 of the Act of 1971 shall apply to the Referees referred to in Article 2 above.
