1. Citation, commencement and interpretation
  2. Days in periods of paid leave not to be treated as days of unemployment
  3. Information to be furnished by mariners on claims for benefit
  4. Removal of disqualification for receiving benefit by reason of absence from Great Britain
  - 4A. Entitlement to a contribution-based jobseeker's allowance for persons outside Great Britain
  5. Evidence of unemployment, incapacity for work or limited capability for work
  6. Special provisions relating to days of unemployment, incapacity for work or limited capability for work in the case of mariners and share fishermen employed on board any ships or vessels
  7. Modification of contribution conditions for receiving benefit in certain circumstances, in respect of mariners employed on board foreign-going ships
  8. Special provisions relating to share fishermen
  9. Application of the Act and regulations
