In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1(2) of the Highlands and Islands Development (Scotland) Act 1965(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Highlands and Islands Development Board Area Extension Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 16th May 1975.

Interpretation

2.—(1) “The Act” means the Highlands and Islands Development (Scotland) Act 1965.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Designated areas

3. The areas described in the Schedule to this order, having regard to their character and their proximity to the area specified in section 1(2) of the Act are hereby designated as other areas within or in relation to which the functions of the Highlands and Islands Development Board shall be exercised, and such other areas as shall, together with the area so specified, be known as the “Highlands and Islands” for the purpose of Section 18(1) of the Act.
