The Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964 (Amendment) Regulations 1977

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 7(1)(b), (2)(a), (6) and (7) of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation with such organisations as appear to them appropriate as representing any interests concerned, hereby make the following Regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964 (Amendment) Regulations 1977, and shall come into operation on 1st August 1977.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964

2. In section 16(3)(f) of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(c) (which enables the Ministers to make regulations requiring persons who grow and deal in seeds to supply information as to, and to keep records of, seed crops grown and harvested by them) for the word "acreages" there shall be substituted the word "areas".
