The Factories (Standards of Lighting) (Revocation)

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 15(1) and (3)(a) of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974(a) ("the 1974 Act") as amended by section 116 of and paragraph 6 of Schedule 15 to the Employment Protection Act 1975(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and for the purpose of giving effect without modifications to proposals submitted to him by the Health and Safety Commission under section 11(2)(d) of the 1974 Act after the carrying out by the said Commission of consultations in accordance with section 50(3) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Factories (Standards of Lighting) (Revocation) Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1978.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if the Regulations revoked by these Regulations were an Act of Parliament repealed by an Act of Parliament.

Revocation of the Factories (Standards of Lighting) Regulations 1941

2. The Factories (Standards of Lighting) Regulations 1941(d) are hereby revoked.

Amendment of the Woodworking Machines Regulations 1974

3. In Regulation 43 of the Woodworking Machines Regulations 1974(e) the words "and the Factories (Standards of Lighting) Regulations 1941" shall be omitted.
