**The Gun Barrel Proof Act 1978
(Commencement No. 1) Order 1978**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 9(3) of the Gun Barrel Proof Act 1978, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Gun Barrel Proof Act 1978 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1978.
2. The provisions of the Gun Barrel Proof Act 1978 specified in the Schedule to this Order shall come into operation on 1st December 1978.
