The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 1(1) of the Crown Agents Act 1979 and article 2(1) of the Ministry of Overseas Development (Dissolution) Order 1979, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Crown Agents Act 1979 (Appointed Day) Order 1979.
2. The appointed day for the purposes of the Crown Agents Act 1979 shall be 1st January 1980.
