The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 61(6) and 62 of the Agriculture Act 1967(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Treasury, hereby make the following order, a draft whereof has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Commons House of Parliament:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Agricultural and Horticultural Co-operation Grants (Extension of Period) Order 1980, and shall come into operation on 15th May 1980.

Extension of Period

2. The period mentioned in subsection (6) of section 61 of the Act (being the period within which proposals in respect of which grant is payable under that section must be submitted to the Central Council for Agricultural and Horticultural Co-operation), having been extended for an additional period of three years beginning on 15th May 1977(b), is hereby extended for a further additional period of three years beginning on 15th May 1980.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further extends, up to 14th May 1983, the period within which applications for grant aid purposes connected with co-operative activities in agriculture or horticulture may be submitted to the Central Council for Agricultural and Horticultural Co-operation. The period would otherwise expire on 14th May 1980. Applications for grant aid purposes are currently made under the Agricultural and Horticultural Co-operation Scheme 1971 (S.I. 1971/415), as amended (S.I. 1977/846).
