Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

And whereas in my opinion there has been a change in the value of money since the 30th March 1977 and the variation made by this Order is in my opinion justified by that change:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 2 of the Representation of the People Act 1978(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Representation of the People (Variation of Limits of Candidates' Election Expenses) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on the day after the day on which it is made.

2. The sums specified in section 64(2)(b)(i) of the Representation of the People Act 1949(b) (limit on candidates' election expenses at an election to the Greater London Council) shall, instead of £320 and 2p, be £500 and 3p respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order increases the maximum amount of candidates' election expenses at an election to the Greater London Council. The increases are such as are justified by the change in the value of money since 30th March 1977, on which date the Representation of the People Act 1977 (which Act last increased those limits) received Royal Assent.
