**The Civil Aviation (Air Travel Organisers' Licensing)
(Fourth Amendment) Regulations 1981**

Made - - - - - *2nd March 1981*
Laid before Parliament *11th March 1981*
Coming into Operation *1st April 1981*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 26 of the Civil Aviation Act 1971(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and after consultation with the Civil Aviation Authority as required by section 26(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation (Air Travel Organisers' Licensing) (Fourth Amendment) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1981.

2. The Civil Aviation (Air Travel Organisers' Licensing) Regulations 1972(b) shall be further amended as follows:—

- (1) in Regulation 1(2) the definition of "broker"; and
- (2) in Regulation 2(2)(b) the words "not being a broker"; shall be deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Civil Aviation (Air Travel Organisers' Licensing) Regulations 1972 by removing the need for brokers (that is to say persons who as agents for airlines and others make available accommodation on aircraft to air travel organisers) to hold an air travel organisers' licence.
