NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE, ENGLAND AND WALES

The National Health Service (Preservation of Boards of Governors) Order 1982

Made	18th February 1982
Laid before Parliament	1st March 1982
Coming into Operation	1st April 1982

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of powers conferred on him by section 15(1), (2), (3) and (5A) of the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with the University of London and the Boards of Governors of Queen Charlotte's Hospital for Women and the Eastman Dental Hospital, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation, duration, and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This order may be cited as the National Health Service (Preservation of Boards of Governors) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1982.
- (2) Unless previously revoked this order shall cease to have effect on 1st April 1983.
 - (3) In this order—
- "the Act of 1973" means the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973:

"the Act of 1977" means the National Health Service Act 1977.

Preservation of certain Boards of Governors of teaching hospitals

2. Section 14 (Abolition of Authorities) of the Act of 1973 shall, while this order is in force, not apply to the Board of Governors of Queen Charlotte's Hospital for Women and the Board of Governors of the Eastman Dental Hospital.

Scope of Order

3. The following provisions have effect in relation to a preserved Board and any person, thing, right, liability or other matter whatsoever connected with a preserved Board.

Repeals and amendments not to apply

4. So much of section 57(1) and (2) of, and Schedules 4 and 5 to, the Act of 1973 as repeals or amends enactments specified in Schedule 1 to this order shall not apply.

Modification of enactments otherwise repealed or amended

5. The enactments set out in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this order which are otherwise repealed or amended by the Act of 1973 shall have effect with such modifications as are specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

Provisions of enactments to have effect with modifications

6. The enactments specified in column 1 of Schedule 3 to this order shall have effect with such modifications as are specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order which takes effect upon the expiration of the National Health Service (Preservation of Boards of Governors) Order 1979 (S.I. 1979/51), which ceases to have effect on 31st March 1982, preserves from abolition under section 14 of the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973 the Boards of Governors of Queen Charlotte's Hospital for Women and the Eastman Dental Hospital for a further period until 1st April 1983 and applies in relation to these preserved Boards various statutory provisions with or without modification (Articles 4 to 6 and Schedules).
