## INDUSTRIAL TRAINING

**The Industrial Training (Construction Board) Order 1964  
(Amendment) Order 1982**

Whereas in relation to the amendments set out in paragraph 2 and 5 of the Schedule to this Order the Secretary of State has consulted the Manpower Services Commission (“the Commission”) under section 1(4)(b) of the Industrial Training Act 1982(a) (“the 1982 Act”) and the Commission has given him a statement of the views of the persons consulted by it in accordance with section 1(5) of that Act;

And whereas in relation to the amendments set out in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the Schedule to this Order the Commission has submitted proposals to the Secretary of State under section 1(4)(a) of the 1982 Act, together with a statement of the views of the persons consulted by it in accordance with section 1(5) of that Act; Now, therefore, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under section 1(1) and (7) of the 1982 Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Industrial Training (Construction Board) Order 1964 (Amendment) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1982.

(2) In this Order—

- (a) “the Board” means the Construction Industry Training Board;
- (b) “levy Order” includes all the levy orders listed in Schedule 2 to the 1980 order and the Industrial Training Levy (Construction Board) Order 1980(b) and the Industrial Training Levy (Construction Board) Order 1981(c);
- (c) “the 1980 Order” means the Industrial Training (Construction Board) Order 1980(d);
- (d) “the principal Order” means the Industrial Training (Construction Board) Order 1964(e).

*Amendment of the principal Order*

2. The principal Order (as amended by the 1980 Order) shall be further amended in accordance with the Schedule to this Order, and accordingly the activities in relation to which the Board exercises the functions conferred by the 1982 Act upon industrial training boards shall be the activities specified in Schedule 1 to the principal Order as amended by the 1980 Order and this Order.

*Transitional provisions*

3.—(1) The chairman and other members of the Board on the day upon which this order comes into operation shall continue to be members of the Board and to hold and vacate their offices in accordance with the terms of the instruments appointing them to be members.

(2) The provisions of this Order shall not—

- (a) extend the operation of a levy Order;
- (b) affect the operation of a levy Order in relation to the assessment of an employer within the meaning of that Order in respect of an establishment that was engaged in the relevant levy period wholly or mainly in activities included in Schedule 1 to the principal Order as amended by the 1980 Order and this Order;
- (c) affect the operation of any assessment notice served by the Board under the provisions of a levy Order before the day upon which this Order comes into operation or any appeal or other proceedings arising out of any such notice.

## SCHEDULE

*Article 2*

## AMENDMENTS TO THE PRINCIPAL ORDER (AS AMENDED BY THE 1980 ORDER)

1. In this Schedule the expression “the Schedule” means Schedule 1 to the principal Order (as amended by the 1980 Order).
2. In paragraph 1 of the Schedule immediately after sub-paragraph (f) there shall be inserted the following:—

“(fa) the manufacture of bricks from clay or calcium silicate for building purposes but excluding bricks made for refractory purposes;”.
3. In paragraph 1 of the Schedule immediately after sub-paragraph (fa) there shall be inserted the following:—

“(fb) the preparation of stone for building purposes;”.
4. In paragraph 2 of the Schedule the words “building or” shall be omitted from sub-paragraph (c)(xvi) thereof.
5. In paragraph 3 of the Schedule immediately after the definition of the word “charity” there shall be inserted the following:—

“Clay” includes shale, brick earth and blaes;”.
6. For the Appendix to the Schedule there shall be substituted the following:—

- (b) the preparation of stone for building purposes.
