The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1982

Made - - - 1st February 1982
Laid before Parliament 8th February 1982
Coming into Operation 1st March 1982

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 85(2) and 107 of the Road Traffic Act 1972 (a), and now vested in him (b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 199(2) of that Act and with the approval of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st March 1982 and may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1982.
- 2. In Regulation 17 (Fees in respect of tests) of the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1981 (c) in paragraph (3) after the words "£10.30" there shall be added the words "if the application for the appointment for the test is received before 1st March 1982 and £13 in any other case".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1981 so as to increase the fee payable by a person who submits himself for a driving test or applies for an appointment for a driving test from £10.30 to £13.
