The Employment Agencies Act 1973 (Exemption) Regulations 1984

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 12(1) and 13(7)(i) of the Employment Agencies Act 1973(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after consultation as required by section 12(2) of the said Act with bodies appearing to him to be representative of the interests concerned, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Employment Agencies Act 1973 (Exemption) Regulations 1984 and shall come into operation on 16th May 1984.

Exemption

- 2.—(1) The Employment Agencies Act 1973 shall not apply to any services provided for its members by any organisation listed in the Schedule to these Regulations.
 - (2) For the purpose of paragraph (1) above "members" includes persons registered with the organisation as trainees or students.
