**The Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (Modification) Order 1984**

2.—(1) Schedule 2 to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (which, as amended<sup>(1)</sup>, specifies the drugs which are subject to control under that Act) shall be amended in accordance with the following provisions of this Article.

(2) In paragraph 1(a) of Part I of that Schedule—

- (a) after “Acetorphine” there shall be inserted “Alfentanil”;
- (b) after “Ethylmethylthiambutene” there shall be inserted “Eticyclidine”;
- (c) after “Racemorphan” there shall be inserted “Rolicyclidine”; and
- (d) after “Sufentanil” there shall be inserted “Tenocyclidine”.

(3) In paragraph 1 of Part II of that Schedule—

- (a) the list of substances and products beginning with “Acetyldihydrocodeine” and ending with “Propiram” shall be designated sub-paragraph (a), and accordingly “(a)” shall be inserted before “Acetyldihydrocodeine”;
- (b) after “Ethylmorphine (3-ethylmorphine)” there shall be inserted “Mecloqualone” and “Methaqualone”;
- (c) after “Methylphenidate” there shall be inserted “Methylphenobarbitone”; and
- (d) there shall be added at the end the following sub-paragraph:—

“(b) any 5,5 disubstituted barbituric acid.”.

(4) In paragraph 1 of Part III of that Schedule—

- (a) after “Dextropropoxyphene” there shall be inserted “Diethylpropion”; and
- (b) “Methaqualone” shall be omitted.
