**The National Health Service (General Medical
and Pharmaceutical Services) Amendment
(No. 2) Regulations 1985**

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	29th March 1985
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	1st April 1985

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of powers conferred on him by sections 29, 41 and 42 of the National Health Service Act 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

(2) In these regulations “Schedule 3A” means Schedule 3A to the National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) Regulations 1974(b) (drugs and other substances not to be prescribed for supply under pharmaceutical services).

Amendment of Schedule 3A

2.—(1) Schedule 3A shall be amended in accordance with the following paragraphs of this regulation.

(2) There shall be substituted for the entries in column 1 of the following table the entries in column 2 of that table:—

(4) After the entry "Tablets to Formula B128" there shall be inserted the entry "Tablets to Formula B141".

(5) After the entry "Vicks Formula 44 Cough Mixture" there shall be inserted the entry "Vicks Inhaler".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations correct errors in, and two omissions from, Schedule 3A to the National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) Regulations 1974 as inserted by the National Health Service (General Medical and Pharmaceutical Services) Amendment Regulations 1985. That Schedule 3A lists drugs and other substances which doctors cannot prescribe for supply under pharmaceutical services under the National Health Service Act 1977.

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
