**The Gaming (Small Charges)
(Scotland) Amendment Order 1988**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 40(2) and 51(4) of the Gaming Act 1968(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Gaming (Small Charges) (Scotland) Amendment Order 1988 and shall come into force on 18th July 1988.

(2) This Order extends to Scotland only.

2. Article 3(b) of the Gaming (Small Charges) (Scotland) Order 1975(2) shall be amended by substituting for the words “the sum of 25p” the words “the sum of 30p”.

3. The Gaming (Small Charges) (Scotland) Amendment Order 1984(3) is hereby revoked.
