The Hallmarking (International Convention) (Amendment) Order 1988


Made - - - - 29th December 1988 Coming into force - - 13th February 1989

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 2(1)(c) and (3), 21(3) and 22(1) of the Hallmarking Act 1973(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the Hallmarking (International Convention) (Amendment) Order 1988 and shall come into force on 13th February 1989.
- **2.** Schedule 2 to the Hallmarking (International Convention) Order 1976(2) is hereby further amended by inserting, after the entry for Austria, the following entry:—

The control mark of the Danish Assay Office is added to the list of foreign Assay Office Marks in the 1976 Order.
