**The Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations 1989**

**PART II**

**REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE FITTING OF LAMPS,  
REFLECTORS, REAR MARKINGS AND DEVICES**

**Lamps to show a steady light**

**13.**—(1) Save as provided in paragraph (2), no vehicle shall be fitted with a lamp which automatically emits a flashing light.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply in respect of—

- (a) a direction indicator;
- (b) a headlamp fitted to an emergency vehicle;
- (c) a warning beacon or special warning lamp;
- (d) a lamp or illuminated sign fitted to a vehicle used for police purposes;
- (e) a green warning lamp used as an anti-lock brake indicator; or
- (f) lamps forming part of a traffic sign.
