The A604 Catthorpe—Harwich Trunk Road (Catthorpe to Rothwell Section and Slip Roads) Supplementary Order 1990

Made - - - - *5th December 1990*

Coming into force - - *24th January 1991*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 10 of the Highways Act 1980⁽¹⁾, and now vested in him⁽²⁾, and of all other enabling powers:

1. For the purpose of connecting the trunk road with another highway, so as to effect a junction at the place stated in the Schedule to this Order, the Secretary of State is authorised to construct a new highway along the route described in that Schedule. That new highway shall become a trunk road as from the date when this Order comes into force.

2. The centre line of the new trunk road is indicated by a heavy black line on the deposited plan.

ROUTE OF THE NEW HIGHWAY
