The Road Traffic (Driver Licensing and Information Systems) Act 1989 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1990

- **2.** The provisions of the Road Traffic (Driver Licensing and Information Systems)Act 1989 specified in the Schedule to this Order shall come into force on 1st June 1990.
