PROCEDURE (GENERAL)

Taking of affidavit in county court proceedings

10.13 In relation to family proceedings pending or treated as pending in a divorce county court, section 58(1) of the County Courts Act 1984 (1) shall have effect as if after paragraph (c) there were inserted the following words—

“or

- (d) a district judge of the principal registry; or
- (e) any officer of the principal registry authorised by the President under section 2 of the Commissioners for Oaths Act 1889(2); or
- (f) any clerk in the Central Office of the Royal Courts of Justice authorised to take affidavits for the purposes of proceedings in the Supreme Court.”.
