**The Social Security (Miscellaneous Provisions)
Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1992**

**PART I
INTRODUCTORY**

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Miscellaneous Provisions) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1992 and shall come into force as follows—

- (a) all provisions other than regulation 5 on 16th November 1992;
- (b) regulation 5 on 4th January 1993.

(2) In these Regulations—

“the Adjudication Regulations” means the Social Security (Adjudication) Regulations 1986(1);

“the Claims and Payments Regulations” means the Social Security (Claims and Payments) Regulations 1987(2);

“the Hospital In-Patients Regulations” means the Social Security (Hospital In-Patients) Regulations 1975(3);

“the Housing Benefit Regulations” means the Housing Benefit (General) Regulations 1987(4);

“the Persons Abroad Regulations” means the Social Security Benefit (Persons Abroad) Regulations 1975(5);

“the Statutory Maternity Pay Regulations” means the Statutory Maternity Pay (General) Regulations 1986(6); and

“the Statutory Sick Pay Regulations” means the Statutory Sick Pay (General) Regulations 1982(7).
