**1992 No. 3159**

**The Specified Diseases (Notification and Slaughter) Order 1992**

**Application of section 22 of the Animal Health Act 1981**

2.—(1) Section 32 of the Animal Health Act 1981, which enables the Minister to cause animals to be slaughtered on account of disease, shall apply to the following diseases—

- African horse sickness
- Bluetongue
- Brucellosis caused by *Brucella melitensis*
- Contagious agalactia
- Contagious epididymitis
- Epizootic haemorrhagic virus disease
- Goat pox
- Lumpy Skin Disease
- Peste des Petits Ruminants
- Rift Valley Fever
- Sheep pox
- Teschen Disease
- Vesicular Stomatitis

(2) For the purposes of this article the definition of “animal” in the Animal Health Act 1981 is hereby extended to include any kind of mammal except man.
