2. The day appointed in respect of paragraphs 8 and 9 of Schedule 4 to the Social Security (Consequential Provisions) Act 1992 (transitory modifications) is 19th April 1993.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

In this Order, 19th April 1993 is appointed as the day on which certain transitory modifications to the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992 (c. 4) (“the Benefits Act”), made by the Social Security (Consequential Provisions) Act 1992, no longer have effect. From that date, interest may be charged in respect of Class 4 contributions payable under the Benefits Act where those contributions are overdue.
