**MAGISTRATES' COURTS**

**The Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Order 1994**

*Made* - - - - *5th December 1994*  
*Laid before Parliament* *9th December 1994*  
*Coming into force* - - *3rd January 1995*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 29(1) and 198(2) of the Licensing Act 1964<sup>(1)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Order 1994 and shall come into force on 3rd January 1995.

2. The Schedule to the Licensing (Fees) Order 1978<sup>(2)</sup> shall be amended by inserting at the end the following entry:

“Grant of Children’s Certificate — s. 168A<sup>(3)</sup> ... .. 6.50”.
