SCHEDULE 1 — REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO PREMISES WHERE DISEASE IS SUSPECTED OR CONFIRMED

PART I — PREMISES ON WHICH DISEASE IS SUSPECTED OR CONFIRMED

1. Record of Poultry
2. Isolation of poultry
3. Prohibition on movement of poultry to or from premises
