**The Fair Trading Act (Amendment)
(Newspaper mergers) Order 1995**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 58(5) of the Fair Trading Act 1973⁽¹⁾, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Fair Trading Act (Amendment) (Newspaper mergers) Order 1995 and shall come into force on 13th June 1995.
2. In section 58(4) of the Fair Trading Act 1973, for “25,000” there shall be substituted “50,000”.
