The Railway Safety (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 1997

Measures to prevent collisions and derailments

- **5.**—(1) A person in control of any infrastructure of a transport system shall ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, that—
 - (a) appropriate procedures are in place;
- (b) where appropriate, equipment which is suitable and sufficient is provided and maintained, for the purpose of preventing any of the events referred to in paragraph (2).
 - (2) The events referred to in paragraph (1) are—
 - (a) collisions between vehicles;
 - (b) collisions between vehicles and buffer-stops;
 - (c) the derailment of vehicles on account of excessive speed or incorrectly set points.
