## The Building Societies (Members' Requisitions) Order 1999

The Building Societies Commission, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by paragraph 20A(13) of Schedule 2 to the Building Societies Act 1986(a), hereby makes the following Order:

## Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Building Societies (Members' Requisitions) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 1st December 1999.

## Amendment of Schedule 2 to the Building Societies Act 1986

2. In paragraph $20 \mathrm{~A}(2)$ of Schedule 2 to the Building Societies Act 1986 (special meeting on members' requisition) for " 100 " there is substituted " 500 ".
