The GLA Roads Designation Order 2000

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14A of the Highways Act 1980(1) hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the GLA Roads Designation Order 2000 and shall come into force on 22nd May 2000.

Designation of GLA roads

2.—(1) The highways specified in the Schedule to this Order are hereby designated as GLA roads.
(2) In accordance with section 14A(2) of the Highways Act 1980 3rd July 2000 is hereby specified as the date on which those highways are to become GLA roads.

Interpretation of the Schedule

3. In the Schedule to this Order—
- (a) a reference to the boundary of London is a reference to the boundary of Greater London;
 - (b) the description of a highway includes the intersection of that road and any other road that crosses it at the same level; and
 - (c) the description of a highway which, or any length of which, is a trunk road includes any highway constructed as part of the trunk road for the purpose of relieving the main carriageway of the trunk road from local traffic.

(1) 1980 c. 66; section 14A was inserted by section 260 of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 (c. 29) (“the 1999 Act”). For the definition of GLA road see the amendments made by section 263 of the 1999 Act. Section 14A(3) provides that orders under section 14A may be made only before the beginning of the term of office of the first Mayor of London. In accordance with section 3(1) of the 1999 Act the first election will be held on 4th May. The first Mayor will thereafter take office in accordance with section 2(8) of the 1999 Act.

THE SCHEDULE

Article 2

ROADS DESIGNATED AS GLA ROADS

“A” Roads (in numerical order)

1. A1 from where it crosses the boundary of London to the south east side of its junction with Wakley Street including the roads which comprise the Archway Interchange.
2. A2 from the boundary of London to its junction with Borough High Street (A3) including—
 - (a) Amersham Road from its junction with New Cross Road to the south side of its junction with Parkfield Road;

4. A3 from the south west side of its junction with Marshalsea Road (A3201) and Great Dover Street (A2) to its junction with Cannon Street and Eastcheap.
5. A4 from the boundary of London to the north east side of its junctions with Park Lane excluding that part of the A4 spur known as Concorde Roundabout at the termination of the M4 spur and the unnamed slip road linking the M4 junction 4a to the junction of Bath Road (A4) and Sipson Road between its junction with Bath Road and Sipson Road and the first unnamed western access road to the Excelsior Hotel, Bath Road but including—
 - (a) Duke of Wellington Place;
 - (b) Grosvenor Place from its junction with Hyde Park Corner to the south east side of its junction with Duke of Wellington Place; and
 - (c) Hyde Park Corner.
6. A5 from the north west side of its junction with St. John’s Wood Road (A5205) to its junction with Marble Arch (A40).
7. A10 from the boundary of London to its junction with Eastcheap excluding the roundabout at M25 junction 25 but including—
 - (a) Evering Road;
 - (b) Manse Road;
 - (c) Northwold Road from its junction with Stoke Newington High Street and Stamford Hill to its junction with Rectory Road; and
 - (d) Rectory Road from its junction with Northwold Road to the south side of its junction with Manse Road.

 - (a) Amersham Road from its junction with Lewisham Way to the south side of its junction with Parkfield Road; and
 - (b) Lewisham Way from its junction with Loampit Hill to the south west side of its junction with Parkfield Road.
- 12.** A21 from its junction with the A224 to its junction with Rushey Green and Sangley Road (A205) excluding—
 - (a) the service road at Pratts Bottom between Broke Farm Drive and Rushmore Hill; and
 - (b) the service road that fronts 137–153 Hastings Road.
- 13.** A21 from its junction with Rushey Green and Brownhill Road (A205) to its junction with Loampit Vale (A20) including Molesworth Street.
- 14.** A22 from the boundary of London to its junction with the A23 at Purley Cross.
- 15.** A23 from the boundary of London to the south east side of its junction with Kennington Park Road (A3) including—
 - (a) Banstead Road;
 - (b) Foxley Lane from the north west side of its junction with Banstead Road to its junctions with Purley Way;
 - (c) Purley Road from its junction with Banstead Road to the south east side of its junction with Russell Hill Parade;
 - (d) Purley Way; and
 - (e) Russell Hill Parade.
- 16.** A23 from the north west side of its junction with Kennington Park Road (A3) to its junction with Kennington Lane (A3204).
- 17.** A24 from the boundary of London to its junction with Long Road and Clapham High Street (A3).

18. A30 from where it crosses the boundary of London to its junction with Bath Road and Great West Road (A4).
19. A40 from the boundary of London to its junction with the Marylebone Flyover including the road formerly known as the A40(M).
20. A40 intersection at Marble Arch from the west side of its junction with Bayswater Road to the east side of its junction with Oxford Street comprising—
 - (a) Cumberland Gate;
 - (b) Marble Arch;
 - (c) Oxford Street from its junction with Marble Arch to the east side of its junction with Park Lane (A4202); and
 - (d) Park Lane from its junction with Oxford Street to the south east side of its junction with Cumberland Gate.
21. A41 from the boundary of London to its junction with Barnet Way and Watford Way (A1).
22. A41 from its junction with Watford Way and Great North Way (A1) to its junctions with Marylebone Road (A501) including—
 - (a) Baker Street from its junction with Park Road to its junction with Marylebone Road (A501);
 - (b) Dorset Square (east side only);
 - (c) Gloucester Place from its junctions with Park Road to the north side of its junction with Dorset Square;
 - (d) Gloucester Place from the south side of its junction with Dorset Square to its junction with Marylebone Road (A501); and

23. A100 from the west side of its junction with Minories (A1211) to its junction with Great Dover Street and Old Kent Road (A2).
24. A101 from its junction with Jamaica Road and Lower Road (A200) to its junction with Branch Road (A1203) including the Rotherhithe Tunnel.
25. A102 from its junction with Lower Clapton Road (A107) to its junction with East Cross Route (A12).
26. A102 from its junction with Blackwall Tunnel Northern Approach (A12) to its junction with Rochester Way Relief Road (A2) including the Blackwall Tunnels and the road formerly known as the Blackwall Tunnel Southern Approach A102(M) and including—
 - (a) Hamelin Street;
 - (b) Robin Hood Lane; and
 - (c) the unnamed slip road south east of East India Dock Road (A13).

Section 260 of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 inserts a new section 14A into the Highways Act 1980 whereby the Secretary of State may designate highways or proposed highways which are to be GLA roads, for which Transport for London will be the highway authority. This Order designates the highways specified in the Schedule as GLA roads with effect from 3rd July 2000.
