**The Primary Care Trusts (Functions)  
(England) Regulations 2000**

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of powers conferred on him by sections 17, 17A(4), 18(1) and (1A) and 126(4) of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

The functions of the Secretary of State under these provisions are, so far as exercisable in relation to Wales, transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by article 2(a) of, and the entry for the 1977 Act in Schedule 1 to, the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999, S.I. 1999/672, as amended by section 66(5) of the 1999 Act.
