## The Health and Social Care Act 2001 (Commencement No. 6) (England) Order 2001

## Citation, interpretation and extent

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Health and Social Care Act 2001 (Commencement No. 6) (England) Order 2001.
  - (2) In this Order—
    - "the Act" means the Health and Social Care Act 2001;
    - "the 1977 Act" means the National Health Service Act 1977(1);
    - "the 1997 Act" means the National Health Service (Primary Care) Act 1997(2);
    - "concluded" in relation to a case falling within article 2(5) means that the NHS Tribunal has given its decision and—
    - (a) any period within which an appeal may be made has expired,
    - (b) an appeal is withdrawn, or
    - (c) all rights of appeal have been exhausted,

as the case may be;

"pharmacist case" means a case before the NHS Tribunal in relation to a person undertaking to provide pharmaceutical services under Part II of the 1977 Act; and

- "the NHS Tribunal" means the tribunal constituted under section 46 of the 1977 Act.
- (3) This Order extends to England only.
