The Education (Admissions Appeals Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2002

Payment of allowances

7.—(1) For the purpose of the payment of financial loss allowance under section 173(4) of the 1972 Act⁽¹⁾, that provision shall apply to any member of an appeal panel constituted in accordance with any of the paragraphs of Schedule 1; and in that section as it so applies the reference to an approved duty shall be read as a reference to attendance at a meeting of an appeal panel.

(2) Section 174(1) of the 1972 Act⁽²⁾ shall apply in relation to any appeal panel constituted in accordance with any of the paragraphs of Schedule 1; and in that section as it so applies, the reference to payments at rates determined by the body in question shall be read as a reference to payments at rates determined—

- (a) by the authority, in the case of an appeal panel constituted under arrangements referred to in regulation 3(a), (d) or (e);
- (b) otherwise by the governing body or bodies of the school or schools in question.
