##### **Criminal Procedure (Insanity) Act 1964 (c. 84)**

5. In section 8(2) of the Criminal Procedure (Insanity) Act 1964 <sup>M1</sup> (interpretation), in the definition of “registered medical practitioner”, after “Medical Act 1983” insert “ who holds a licence to practise ”.
