## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order repeals provisions in the Health and Social Services and Social Security Adjudications Act 1983 relating to the Central Council for Training and Education in Social Work ("CCETSW"). The functions of the CCETSW are abolished in relation to England and Wales by section 70 of the Care Standards Act 2000; in relation to Northern Ireland by section 17 of the Health and Personal Social Services Act (Northern Ireland) 2001 and in relation to Scotland under section 67 of the Regulation of Care (Scotland) Act 2001.

CCETSW's assets and liabilities were transferred under the Central Council for Education and Training in Social Work (Transfer Scheme) Order 2001 (S.I.2001/2561), subject to certain savings. Those savings provisions are now revoked (article 4) and any remaining assets and liabilities of CCETSW are transferred to the Secretary of State or the successor bodies established under the above-mentioned Acts.
