### The Land Registration Act 2002 (Commencement No. 2) Order 2003

Made - - - - 2nd April 2003

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 136(2) of the Land Registration Act 2002(a), makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Land Registration Act 2002 (Commencement No. 2) Order 2003.
- **2.** The following provisions of the Land Registration Act 2002 shall come into force on 28th April 2003—
  - (a) section 107 and Schedule 9; and
  - (b) paragraph 28 of Schedule 11 and, so far as it relates to that paragraph, section 133.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings into force on 28th April 2003 the following provisions of the Land Registration Act 2002—

- section 107, which contains provisions relating to the appointment and qualification of the Adjudicator to Her Majesty's Land Registry and gives effect to Schedule 9;
- Schedule 9, which makes further provision about the Adjudicator; and
- Schedule 11, paragraph 28, which adds the Adjudicator to Her Majesty's Land Registry to the list of office holders in Schedule 5 to the Judicial Pensions and Retirement Act 1993 subject to compulsory retirement at 70 with the possibility of annual extension up to 75.
