Citation and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Energy Act 2004 (Commencement No. 3) Order 2004.
- (2) In this Order, "the Act" means the Energy Act 2004.

Commencement

- 2.—(1) The provisions of the Act specified in Schedule 1 shall come into force on 5th October 2004
- (2) The provisions of the Act specified in Schedule 2 shall come into force on 1st December 2004.
