**The Local Government Act 2003
(Commencement No. 2 and Savings) Order 2004**

Savings

4.—(1) Section 58 of the Local Government Finance Act 1988⁽¹⁾ shall continue to have effect for the purpose of making regulations, and amending regulations made under that section in relation to any relevant period⁽²⁾ ending before 1st April 2005, as if—

- (a) section 65 of the Act; and
- (b) in Schedule 7 to the Act, paragraphs 10, 11 and 24(3);

had not been commenced.

(2) Regulations made under section 58 of the Local Government Finance Act 1988⁽³⁾ shall continue to have effect in relation to any relevant period ending before 1st April 2005 as if—

- (a) section 65 of the Act; and
- (b) in Schedule 7 to the Act, paragraphs 10, 11 and 24(3);

had not been commenced.

(3) Section 138 of and Schedules 7 and 8 to the Local Government Finance Act 1988 shall continue to have effect in relation to any non-domestic rating multiplier for any financial year ending before 1st April 2005, as if—

- (a) section 62 of the Act;
- (b) in Schedule 7 to the Act, paragraphs 20, 21, 25(4), (5) and (6), and 26(3);
- (c) in Schedule 8 to the Act, the repeals of paragraph 6(3) of Schedule 10 to, and paragraph 84(2)(b) of Schedule 13 to, the Local Government Finance Act 1992,

had not been commenced.
