PART 2

AUTHORISATION OF ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

Conditions to be satisfied

4.—(1) An individual will not be authorised to act as an enforcement officer unless the conditions in paragraph (2) are satisfied.

- (2) The individual must not—
 - (a) have been convicted of any criminal offence—
 - (i) for which he received a custodial sentence; or
 - (ii) involving dishonesty or violence;
 - (b) be liable for any unpaid fines;
 - (c) be liable for any court judgment granted within the last 6 years which remains unsatisfied;
 - (d) be an undischarged bankrupt;
 - (e) have been disqualifed from acting as a director of a company within the last 6 years;
 - (f) carry on or be involved in any business relating to or including the purchase or sale of debts.
