The Local Authorities (Goods and Services)(Public Bodies)(England) Order 2004

Made----27th February 2004Laid before Parliament3rd March 2004Coming into force-23rd March 2004

The First Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(5) and (6) of the Local Authorities (Goods and Services) Act 1970(a) hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Authorities (Goods and Services) (Public Bodies)(England) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 23rd March 2004.

Designation as a public body

2. Each of the following bodies, being a person appearing to the Secretary of State to be exercising a function of a public nature, shall be a public body for the purposes of the Local Authorities (Goods and Services) Act 1970, in its application to England(b):

Pyramid Schools (Cornwall) Limited(c);and

Haden Building Management Limited(d).

Restrictions on agreements – Pyramid Schools (Cornwall) Limited

3. Agreements which may be entered into by Pyramid Schools (Cornwall) Limited, by virtue of this Order, shall be subject to the following restrictions—

⁽a) 1970 c.39. The power conferred on the Minister of Housing and Local Government is exercisable by the Secretary of State; see article 2 of the Secretary of State for the Environment Order 1970 (S.I. 1970/1681), and see also SI 1977/2971.

⁽b) the Secretary of State's functions under the Local Authorities (Goods and Services)Act 1970, so far as exercisable in relation to Wales, are transferred to the National Assembly for Wales; see article 2 and Schedule 1 to the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I 1999/672), to which there are amendments not relevant to this Order.

⁽c) Pyramid Schools (Cornwall) Limited was incorporated as a private limited company, limited by shares on 8th December 2003, and is registered under company No. 4988242.

⁽d) Haden Building Management Limited was incorporated as a private limited company, limited by shares on 27th January 1998, and is registered under company No. 598379.

- (a) that any such agreements are for the provision of catering services to it by Cornwall County Council; and
- (b) that any such agreements are made in connection with the provision of services in the area of Cornwall County Council.

Restrictions on agreements - Haden Building Management Limited

- **4.** Agreements which may be entered into by Haden Building Management Limited, by virtue of this Order, shall be subject to the following restrictions—
 - (a) that any such agreements are for the supply of cleaning, waste, hygiene, and pest and rodent control services to it by Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council; and
 - (b) that any such services are made in connection with the provision of services in the area of Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

Article 2 of this Order designates each of the bodies listed as a public body for the purposes of the Local Authorities (Goods and Services) Act 1970 ("the 1970 Act").

The effect of the designation is to allow each of the local authorities concerned to provide goods and services listed by way of an agreement for any purpose prescribed by section 1(1) of the 1970 Act

Articles 3 and 4 impose restrictions on the agreements that can be made by each of the bodies by virtue of this Order.
