The International Organisations Act
2005 (Commencement) Order 2005

Made - - - - 30th June 2005

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 11(4) of the International Organisations Act 2005(1), hereby makes the following Order —

1. This Order may be cited as the International Organisations Act 2005 (Commencement) Order 2005.
2. Sections 1 and 2 of the International Organisations Act 2005 shall come into force on 11th July 2005.
3. Section 3 of the International Organisations Act 2005 shall come into force on 6th April 2006, which is the day specified as the relevant day for the purposes of paragraph 5A of the Schedule to the Commonwealth Secretariat Act 1966(2).
