Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Collection of Fines (Pilot Schemes) (Amendment No. 4) Order 2005 and shall come into force on the 12th December 2005.

The 2004 Order established the piloting of different provisions of the fines collection scheme contained in Schedule 5 to the Courts Act 2003 in different local justice areas. This Order extends the Schedule of the 2004 Order to enable the fines collection scheme to be piloted in more local justice areas.
