## Classes of Harm

## **Class IV**

- **4.** A Class IV harm is such moderate harm as is reasonably foreseeable as a result of the hazard in question, including—
  - (a) pleural plaques;
  - (b) occasional severe discomfort;
  - (c) benign tumours;
  - (d) occasional mild pneumonia;
  - (e) broken finger;
  - (f) slight concussion;
  - (g) moderate cuts to face or body;
  - (h) severe bruising to body;
  - (i) regular serious coughs or colds.
