- (2) In regulation 1(2) (interpretation), after the definition of "the 1995 Act" insert—""the 2004 Act" means the Pensions Act 2004;".
- (3) In regulation 16A(2) M2 (circumstances in which notice of an employer's failure to make payments to trustees or managers need not be given), for sub-paragraph (b) substitute the following—
 - "(b) where the scheme is exempt from the requirement to prepare, review and if necessary revise a schedule of contributions under section 227 of the 2004 Act, by virtue of any of sub-paragraphs (a) to (i) and (k) to (m) of regulation 17(1) of the Occupational Pension Schemes (Scheme Funding) Regulations 2005; or".
