

## SCHEDULE 1

### Amendments to the Registered Designs Act 1949

5. For section 45 there shall be substituted—

**“45 Application to Scotland**

(1) In the application of this Act to Scotland—

“account of profits” means accounting and payment of profits;

“accounts” means count, reckoning and payment;

“arbitrator” means arbiter;

“assignment” means assignation;

“claimant” means pursuer;

“costs” means expenses;

“defendant” means defender;

“delivery up” means delivery;

“injunction” means interdict;

“interlocutory relief” means interim remedy.

(2) References to the Crown shall be construed as including references to the Crown in right of the Scottish Administration.”.
