**The Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000  
(Commencement No.11 and Savings) Order 2006**

**Appointed day**

**2.** 2nd May 2006 is the day appointed for the coming into force of the following provisions of the Act—

- (a) section 47 (redesignation of roads used as public paths);
- (b) section 48 (restricted byway rights);
- (c) section 49 (provisions supplementary to sections 47 and 48);
- (d) section 50 (private rights over restricted byways);
- (e) section 51 (which gives effect to Schedule 5) insofar as it relates to the provisions of Schedule 5 mentioned in paragraph (g) below;
- (f) section 102 (which gives effect to Schedule 16) insofar as it relates to the entry in Part II of Schedule 16 referring to section 54 of the 1981 Act;
- (g) in Schedule 5 (amendments relating to definitive maps and statements and restricted byways)—
  - (i) paragraph 1;
  - (ii) paragraphs 6 and 7;
  - (iii) paragraph 9; and
  - (iv) paragraphs 12 to 17.
