The Avian Influenza (Preventive Measures) (England) Regulations 2006

Extension of the power to cause vaccination

- **10.** The following provisions of the Act apply as if vaccination under these Regulations was carried out in exercise of the power to vaccinate in section 16(1) of the Act—
 - (a) section 16(2) to (17)(1) (treatment after exposure to infection);
 - (b) section 16A(2) (slaughter of vaccinated animals);
 - (c) section 62A(3) (slaughter: power of entry).
